Dear Sir,

I have this morning been favoured with yours of the 27<sup>th</sup> instant, accompanying printed notices for Recruiting - I have caused them to be put up - but being unacquainted with the Service, will be much obliged to you for your instructions how I am to proceed should any men come in the way -

It is requisite that some printed attestations be sent to this place, for they may be required - In what way are we to be furnished with interesting Money and Rewards to bringers - are the Recruits to be examined by a Surgeon as is customary and will Mr. Hilton be employed for that purpose?

There has been only six notices sent here, if you could spare two or three more I would have them sent to Chestnut and the Neighbourhood - those I have got are put up at the principal entrances to Waltham Abbey, and in the Public Houses - and with best wishes to you, and for your Success I remain
