

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- 1. Room next Grand Jury Room. Large Map Framed on Wall. Map of the County of Essex. Surveyed 1772 to 1774 published as the Act directs October 1st 1777 by John Chapman (of Royal Academy Pall Mall) This Map is on a very large scale covering the greater part of the Wall and is the same map as that in the possession of Mr. W.C. Metcalfe of 10, Lupus St. his being bound in parts and consequently handier.
- 2. Large Map same as the last but rolled up and dilapidated but handier to get at.
- 3. Large Map of Essex in Grand Jury Room no date. First part General Ordnance Survey England and Wales by Lt. Colonel Moody R.A. F.R. S. Rolled up on Wall.
- 4. Map of Essex 1840 by Colonel Colley F.R.S., M.R.I.A. dated July 1st 1840 engraved at Tower of London by Ordnance Map Office Electrotyped in 1864 Writing by J.A. Harrison and B.B. Baker Published by Stanford 6, Charing Cross, engraved at Ordnance Map Office Southampton ruling by J.W. Froggett and E. George. The hills by Alfred Baker. Published by Colonel Colley R.E. July 12th 1844.
- 5. Old Map of Essex by Morden shewing the Hundreds and Town of Colchester. This is framed in the County Surveyors Office.
