1735 Between Richard Wateman of Holme Square in the County of Middlesex
Coyse of the one part and John Walker of London Merchant of the other part
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the yearly rent and covenants in these
present reserved and contained in the part and behalf of the said John Walker
his executors administrators and assigns to be paid done and performed the said
Richard Wateman hath demised granted and to farm Let to and by these presents
withth dense grant once to farm out unto the said John Walker all that the
lease at Hooke Priory in Wallham Abey in the County of Essex upon the River
Sea with the water and fishery thereof from Holywell Priory above the said River to a
place commonly called Stack Stich upon the same River also all those four grass
islands abutting upon Chestnut Pithay also one other grass Island abutting on
fishers Farm also one other Island below theumpke planted with Cypres also
two grass Islands lying by the Abbey Head side also one grass Island lying by
Commons Head also one Grass Island by Green Head Gate also 4 Islands
by the Marsh three thereof grass and one planted with Cypres also all those two
Grass Islands below Wallham Farm adjoyning to Green Head and Spine Stones
also one Cypre Island at Rose Hill one other Cypre Island at theumpke Hill
and also one Grass Island commonly called Penses Island adjoyning to Hooke
Marsh Lake and the Worder Mill River now in the occupation of the said John
Walker his undestendants or assigns once also all ways passages easements waters
watercourses bridges stiles profits commodities and appurtenances whatsoever to the
said Rose Hooke Islands and premises with the appurtenances belonging or in
anywise appertaining or therewith usually let or used occupied or enjoyed I have
and do hold the said Rose Islands and premises hereby demised with the appurts
belonging or in anywise appertaining or therewith usually let or used occupied or
enjoyed and every part and parcel thereof unto the said John Walker his exec
utors and assigns from the first day of the Month of Our Lord Christ last
past for and during one unto the full end and term of 2 years from thence next
ensuing and fully to be complete and ended holding and paying therfore yearly
and every year during the said term of 2 years hereby granted unto the said
Richard Wateman his executors assigns the yearly rent or sum of £ 24 of good and
lawfull money of Great Britain on the first most usual feasts or days of payment

in the year that is to say the annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary the
Feast of Saint John the Baptist the Feast of St Michael the Archangel and the Birth
of Our Lord Christ by even and equal portions free and clear and without any
deduction for any manner of taxes assessments subsidies or impositions whatsoever
the first payment to be made on the feast of the annunciation of the Blessed
Virgin next ensuing the date of these presents And the said John Walton for himself
his executors administrators and assigns doth covenant promise and agree to and
with the said Richard Bateman his heirs and assigns that he the said John Walton
his executors administrators or assigns shall and will well and truly pay or
cause to be paid unto the said Richard Bateman his heirs or assigns the
said yearly rent or sum of £24 on the days and times and in manner
aforesaid free and clear and without any deduction or abatement out of the
same or any part thereof for any manner of taxes assessments or dutys
whatsoever according to the reservation thereof and true intent & meaning
of these presents And also that he the said John Walton his executors administrators
and assigns shall and will at his their or some of their own proper charge
pay and discharge all such taxes assessments subsidies and all other Publick
or parliamentary taxes and other dutys whatsoever which at any time or times
during the said term shall be taxed charged assessed or imposed upon or
grow due and payable and to be paid for or in respect of the said premises
by the Landlord of the said premises or the said John Walton his executors
administrators or assigns in respect thereof and shall and will at all times
hereafter during the said term hereby lett or acquit discharge save harmless &
keep indemnified the said Richard Bateman his heirs and assigns and the said
premises therefrom and from all charges seizures payments and damages by
reason thereof and also that the said John Walton his executors administrators
and assigns shall and will at his their or one of their own proper costs and
charges from time to time and at all times hereafter during the said term
hereby granted when and so often as need or occasion shall be or require
well and sufficiently and in good husbandlike manner make amend & at
all times during the said term preserve maintain uphold and keep in
good repair the said Ware Bridges Stiles and premises with the appurtenances
thereto belonging & the said premises being so well and sufficiently repaired amended
preserved upheld maintained and in good repair kept as aforesaid shall and will
at the end of the said term hereby lett or other sooner determination of this
present Lease which shall just happen peaceably and quietly leave surrende

and yield up unto the said Richard Bateman his heirs & assigns ^{Dearded} nevertheless that if it shall happen the said yearly rent or sum of twenty four pounds or any part thereof shall be behind and unpaid by the space of 14 days next over or after any or either of the said Feast days or days of payment wherein the same ought to be paid as aforesaid (being first lawfully demanded that then & from thenceforth it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Richard Bateman his heirs or assigns into the said hereby demised premises or any part thereof in the name of the whole wholly to reenter and the same to have again return reposess and enjoy as in his and their first and former Estate and the said John Walton his executors administrators or assigns and all other occupiers of the said demised premises thereout and from thenceforth utterly to expell put out and amove this Indenture or anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding And the said Richard Bateman for himself his heirs and assigns doth by these presents covenant promise and grant to and with the said John Walton his executors administrators and assigns that the said John Walton his executors administrators and assigns well and truly performing paying fulfilling and keeping the rent and covenants hereinbefore reserved and contained on his and their parts and behalfe to be paid performed and kept shall and lawfully may peaceably and quietly have hold use occupy posses and enjoy the said Weare Islands and premises hereby demised with there and every of their appurtenances without the lawful lett out trouble molestation interruption or disturbance of or by the said Richard Bateman his heirs or assigns or any person or persons claiming or to claim by from or under him them or any or other of them In witness whereof the said partys to these presents interchangeably have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written)
