In welcoming the publication of the first Staff Bulletin I should point out that it is experimental in regard both to subject matter and format. The suggestion was originally made to me, I think, by Mr. Gravener, Safety Officer, that newcomers to this widely scattered Establishment might more quickly get acquainted with one another, and become known to their colleagues, if a news-sheet were distributed giving brief particulars of their careers-to-date, hobbies etc. I shall certainly be interested to hear later whether there is tangible evidence of this purpose having been achieved, and of any suggestions for improving the Bulletin.

What can be done to improve the situation? The initiative, if it is to be taken, will have to come from amongst us, and it will need to be extremely well directed to be fruitful. The first essential is to decide what objectives are practicable and what are not, make a plan, and consider means of raising money. It is no less essential to find some way of ensuring that interest in the plan, and the drive behind it, can be maintained over a few years, since the present situation cannot be remedied quickly. Perhaps the best way is to have good short-term objectives too. I would draw the attention of all new entrants, and of some old ones, to the existence of the Social & Sports Club, (Secretary: Miss Dilys Jones, Analytical Section; Subscription Secretary: Mr. R.G. Williams, Engineering Section, No. 9 Powdermill Lane).

Finally I wish to express my thanks to S.A.O. for undertaking the task of collecting and collating the information given in this Bulletin.
