Perhaps the best way is to have good short-term objectives too. I would draw the attention of all new entrants, and of some old ones, to the existence of the Social & Sports Club, (Secretary: Miss Dilys Jones, Analytical Section; Subscription Secretary: Mr. R.G.Williams, Engineering Section, No. 9 Powdermill Lone).

Finally I wish to express my thanks to S.A.O. for undertaking the task of collecting and collating the information given in this Bulletin.
