Sir

Agreeable to your letter of 11<sup>th</sup> Inst. we herewith enclose a Report of the Journals of the Rev Officers & Clerks at this place from the time each of them first obtained a warrant; we beg to observe that the following persons served as Clerks by appointment, prior to the warrants

- James Wright - at Woolwich from the 1<sup>st</sup> July 1758 by appointment of the Lieut. General His Grace the Duke of Marlborough Mast. General, being then in Germany
- John Howdesly - at Portsmouth from 12 Oct. 1772 Appointed by General Conway
- Henry Dugleby - at Woolwich act as Clerk from 1 Jan<sup>y</sup> 1781
