## A hiding place on Sun Street

With the intriguing title of "A Gunpowder Plot" the exhibition that is currently on show at the museum in Sun Street, Waltham Abbey traces the history of the 200 years of activity on the site of the Royal Armament Research & Development establishment that was built in 1787.

The exhibition which is on loan to the museum from RARDE includes many historical items including an elephant hide bench to prevent sparks whilst working, as well as up to the minute videos on RARDE'S experimental work for Her Majesty's Government.
