Death of William Rahn, drowned. 29.4.1907

As I informed you by telephone this morning, I regret very much to have to report the death by drowning in this factory, on Saturday afternoon, of William Rahn, a Millman, and former Pensioner, 57 1/2 years of age, and with 25 1/2 years of excellent service.

The necessary communications have been made to the Police & the Coroner with the view to the inquiry. The matter is being investigated. At present there is no evidence forthcoming to show that the fatality arose out of the man's employment. The evidence would rather seem to point the other way.
