The Gunpowder stove originally consisted of a central boiler house, similar to 26, with gunpowder drying buildings to the North and South, They were both served by covered boat houses at either end. The whole was surrounded by a U shaped canal leading off from the mill stream. The Stove was demolished around 1910 during the construction of the Tetryl Factory. Remains of the substantial central boiler house and surrounding canal may lie beneath the site of the Tetryl Factory.
