Instruments directly connected to the Central Exchange are numbered from 1 to 99.

Instruments directly connected to the N.G. Exchange are numbered from 101 to 199.

Instruments directly connected to the Lower Works Exchange are numbered from 401 to 449.

Instruments directly connected to Lower Cordite Exchange are numbered from 450 - 499.

Telephone Numbers should be used, not names.

In making a call to an instrument which is connected to your Exchange, ask for the number required.

In making a call to an instrument not connected to your Exchange, ask Operator for the Exchange required. On being connected ask for the number.

When the operator makes a connection for you to another Exchange he will tell you "You're Through".

When you have finished the call
